AT LAST, we've done it! The Isle of Man Government have awarded us a £100,000 International Development Grant to help build a new hospital unit at Bwindi Community Hospital (BCH), Uganda.

This grant unlocks a further £60,000 of UK pledges/monies already raised. Our £160,000 of funds will be added to those already raised by US charity, the Kellerman Foundation. Together, we have raised a total of £400,000! The BCH dream of a state-of-the-art Dental-Vision Clinic now promises to become a reality!

Our 165-page(!) grant application involved a huge amount of hard work and several sleepless nights but it has eventually paid off! We are grateful to everyone involved with special thanks going to:
